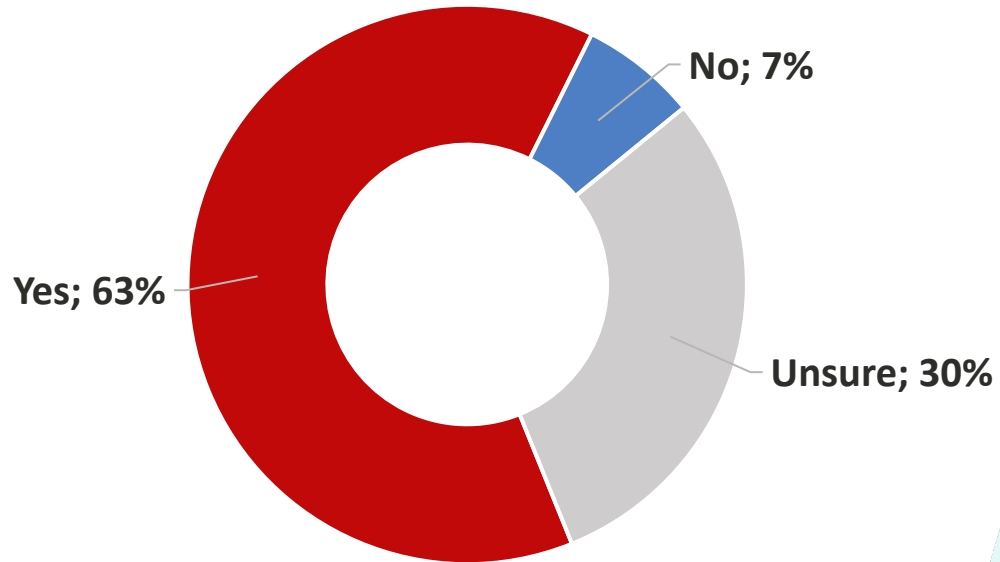

63% think Aucklanders should own the Port

Q: Do you think Aucklanders should continue to own and profit from the Auckland Port? (%)



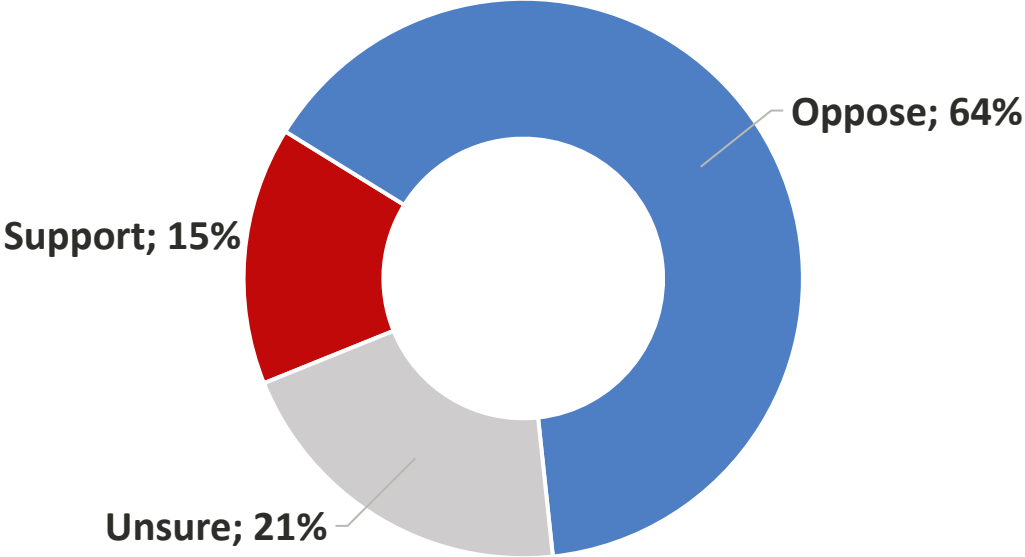
Men (68%) were more likely to say we should continue to own the port compared to women (59%). As were older respondents:

- Under 30 ... 57%
- 30-44 66%
- 45-59 57%
- 60+ 74%



64% oppose the sale

Q: Mayor Wayne Brown has suggested selling the Auckland Port to overseas investors. Do you support or oppose the sale of the Port? (%)



Women (70%) were more likely to **oppose** the sale compared to men (60%). As were older respondents:

- Under 30 ... 55%
- 30-44 66%
- 45-59 66%
- 60+ 72%



ACT (83%) and Labour (80%) voters were more likely to oppose the sale than Green (64%) and National (54%) voters

Methodology

- ▲ New Zealand results in this report are based upon questions asked in the Talbot Mills Research online nation-wide daily tracking survey between the 4th and the 9th of October 2023.
- ▲ The results are based on a nationally representative sample of 517 Aucklanders 18 years of age and over.
- ▲ The maximum margin of error for a sample size of 517 for a 50% figure at the 95% confidence level is $\pm 4.3\%$.

Note on rounding:

- ▲ All numbers are shown rounded to zero decimal places. Hence specified totals are not always exactly equal to the sum of the specified sub-totals. The differences are seldom more than 1%.
- ▲ For example: $2.7 + 3.5 = 6.2$ would appear: $3 + 4 = 6$.
